The manuals, in pdf format, can be found in your MacRepertory and ReferenceWorks folders on your Hard Drive. You will need Acrobat Reader installed in order to view them. If you don't have Acrobat Reader installed already, you may install it by using the "**Install acrobat reader4.exe**" which can be found in your MacRepertory and ReferenceWorks/Extras Folders or on the Application CD (or Disk 1). For Macintosh users

Please open your **MacRepertory Folder** from your Hard Drive and locate your **MacRepertory Pro Manual.pdf**.

To locate your ReferenceWorks manual, please open your **ReferenceWorks Folder** and locate your ***ReferenceWorks Pro Manual.pdf**.

For Windows users

Please open your **MacRepertory Folder** on your Hard Drive and locate your **MacRepertory Manuals** folder. Inside you will find your **MacRepertory Pro Manual.pdf**.
