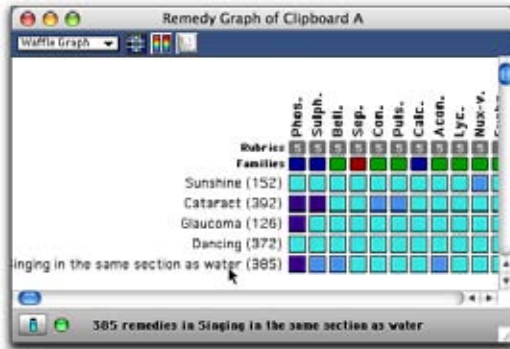


THE REMEDY GRAPH



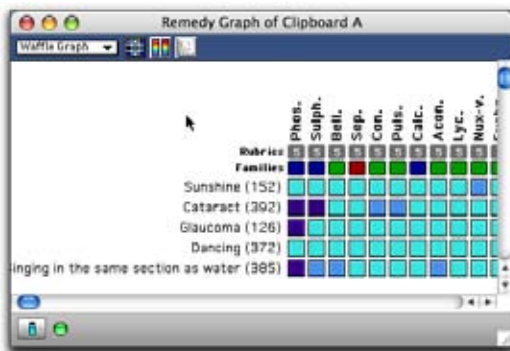
The Remedy Graph Window displays a graph of the remedies from the rubrics in the highlighted rubric clipboard.

The order of the remedies is based on the analysis strategy that is selected from the Analyze menu (in turn the strategy takes into account the number of phrases that were found, the grades of the words in the phrase, the values of the books, the Phrase Strength of each phrase, ec.).

REMEDY GRAPH BUTTONS



At the top of the Remedy Graph window are a number of buttons and a pop-down menu. These buttons represent the default remedy graphs. The pop-down menu gives the name of each button. The default choices are a waffle, multigraph and scatter graph.



The waffle graph crosses the remedies with the rubrics. The color of the square shows how strongly each remedy had the rubric. To determine the grade ReferenceWorks looks at how many times the phrase was found, how strongly (in capitals, bold, etc.), and the size of the descriptions for the remedy; most remedies end up in the first grade. The default strategy for the waffle graph is Number of Rubrics which sorts the remedies by their ability to cover all rubrics in the same and secondarily by how unusual they are.

Sometimes the full name of rubric is clipped by the edge of the window. Put your cursor anywhere in the squares of the graph, hold down the cmd/ctrl key and drag to the right. The graph part of the window will move and more of the rubric will be visible.

Type the first couple of letters of the word. The graph immediately moves to the first remedy with those letters.

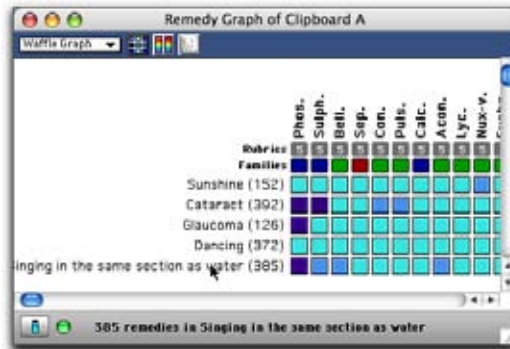
If you are interested in reading about one of the remedies that appear in the graph, simply click on its name and the Materia Medica window will open showing those books that contain a description of the remedy.

LIMITS

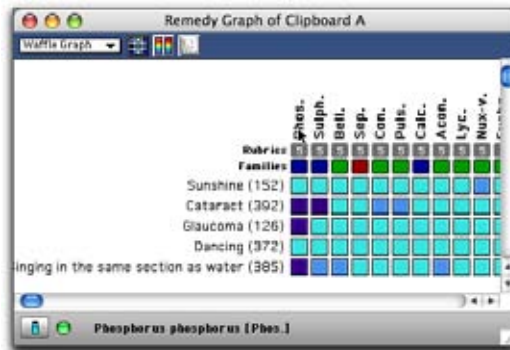
The only limit available in this window is remedies. The remedy limit allows you to trim the search to just those remedies you are interested in.

ROLL OVERS

Roll your cursor over a Rubric, and the bottom scroll bar will tell you the full name of that rubric.



To see the full name of the remedy in the graph roll your cursor over a remedy and the full name of that remedy will appear in the scroll bar at the bottom of window.



DRAG AND DROP

Drag a remedy to the materia medica window (or its icon in the Icon Tool Palette) to see the remedy's materia medica.
